


# COMMON QUESTIONS



## 1 What is a transfer student?

Transfer applicants are high school graduates who have completed a minimum of 24 transferable units at the time of application. Applicants with fewer than 24 units at the time of application should apply as a freshman.

## 2 Do you have GPA requirements for admission?

**YES.** The minimum weighted cumulative GPA requirement to transfer is 2.5 or higher.

## 3 Does Woodbury have agreements with community colleges to assist with transferring credit?

**YES.** Woodbury maintains agreements with several local community colleges to assist with transferring credits. If a guide is not available, you can also view transfer equivalencies by using the Transfer Course Evaluation System (TES) on our website.

## 4 Does Woodbury require the IGETC or Cal-GETC to transfer?

**NO.** Woodbury does not require applicants to complete the IGETC or Cal-GETC prior to transferring. Applicants can transfer as soon as they meet our minimum unit requirements.

## 5 If I earn an associate degree, am I guaranteed junior standing?

This will depend on your major. Students applying to Woodbury's School of Business who earn an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) in Business Administration from a California community college are guaranteed junior standing if these courses are passed with a "C" or better.

However, this does not apply to our design majors. Design credit will be determined by your department after submission of your portfolio.

## 6 What classes do you require to transfer?

Woodbury does not have course-specific requirements for transfer. However, we do encourage that the following courses are completed at a local community college. This provides students with more course options upon their transfer. Suggested courses include:

- English Composition
- College-Level Math course
- Public Speaking
- Environmental Studies

## 7 Do you require a portfolio to transfer?

This will depend on your major. Students applying to *Architecture, Animation + VFX, Experience Design, Fashion Design, Game Art and Design, and Interior Design* will be required to submit a portfolio.

## 8 Are there pre-requisite course requirements for business majors?

Woodbury does not have pre-requisite course requirements for transfer. However, we recommend Business students prioritize the following courses at their local community college:

- Introduction to Business
- Business Law
- College Algebra or Business Algebra
- Statistics
- Economics (Micro or Macro)
- Financial Accounting
- Managerial Accounting

Students interested in transferring at the junior level should complete an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) in Business Administration and pass all courses with a “C” or better.



# HOW TO APPLY

## APPLICATION STEPS

- 1** Submit the Woodbury Application at [woodbury.redlands.edu/apply](http://woodbury.redlands.edu/apply)
- 2** Submit official college transcripts from all institutions attended
- 3** Submit an official high school transcript or official equivalency exam transcript.  
\*Required if an associate degree has not been earned.
- 4** Submit a digital portfolio. \*Required for students applying to select design programs.
- 5** Submit letters of recommendation and/or personal statement. \*Optional but encouraged.
- 6** Submit official AP, IB HL, and/or CLEP exam scores. \*Required if a passing score was received.

# FINANCIAL AID

## Making Higher Education Affordable

With a Range of Financial Aid Options, we offer personalized assistance to put your dreams—and the cost of your educational journey—within reach for you and your family. We are committed to supporting you every step of the way through scholarships, grants, and personalized financial counseling services.

### MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

To encourage and reward academic excellence, Woodbury University awards undergraduate merit scholarships based on a student's academic promise and personal accomplishments. Merit scholarships are awarded to students in their first year at Woodbury. Merit placement is determined by a review of the student's cumulative college GPA.

As long as the required GPA is maintained, these merit awards are renewable for up to an additional three years for standard programs or up to four years for architecture students.

- » **Presidential Merit Scholarship \$20,000**  
3.7 GPA and above
- » **Dean Merit Scholarship \$18,000**  
3.4 - 3.69 GPA
- » **Woodbury Educational Grant \$12,000**  
2.95 - 3.39 GPA
- » **Woodbury Educational Grant \$8,000**  
2.5 - 2.94 GPA

### CALCULATING YOUR COSTS

These costs are designed to help families determine how much it will cost to attend Woodbury University. With a Transfer GPA of 3.40–3.69, the following scholarships and grants significantly reduce annual tuition cost:
